But some factors stand in the way of energy development in India. They are variations in climate, labor problems, and a lack of sufficient coal reserves. The Palghat Local Centre organized a Forum (group discussion) on 28th April 2023 at the Seminar Hall of the Local Centre at 6.00 p.m. Er. K. Madana Mohana, Chairman of IEI Palghat Local Centre was the moderator

industrial organizations shall set up solar power plants at least 10% of their total demand, said Dr. K K Babu, Ombudsman, MGNREGS & PMAY (G), Palakkad District and Former Principal Jyothi Engineering College. Dr. Pradip. C, Hon. Secretary added that rooftop domestic solar plants have to be set up not looking into their economic aspects but considering their environmental aspects and individual commitment to attain sustainability. However, the requirements of the night have to be met either by storage devices or from base load plants that used nonrenewable fuels. Er. Sudhir P.I. Former G.M. Thermax Ltd on his address added that solar panels have to be maintained through proper cleaning for which robotic methods can be apt especially when it is difficult for manpower to reach the installed locations. He also added that solar alone cannot be the solution for the upcoming energy requirements, since the efficiency of solar energy generation is very less. Dr. C. Pradip, Honorary Secretary presented a brief on the Indian energy scenario for 2022 and the share of various energy sources. The energy prices were also presented to the group. Regulations have to be formed so that it becomes statutory for large

disadvantageous to customers installing rooftop solar plants he added. Er. A V Rajappan, Managing Director, Navabharath Systems and Devices Pvt. Ltd stressed the need for harvesting solar energy to its maximum since it is the cleanest source of renewable energy. Technology is advancing and nuclear power definitely can be an option to cater to the increasing energy demand opined Dr. K K Babu. The experiments with hydrogen fuels on automobiles were presented to the group by Er. Madanamohan. Modernization of thermal plants to enhance their efficiency, better battery technologies for storage of solar power, usage of solar concentrators for energy generation, private participation in renewable energy generation, and enhancing power transmission efficiency were also discussed in the meeting.
