

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN



THE INSTITUTION OF ENGINEERS (INDIA)

AND

CONSULTING ENGINEERS ASSOCIATION OF INDIA (CEAI)

Preamble

The Institution of Engineers (India) (IEI) and the Consulting Engineers Association of India (CEAI) have entered into this Agreement on 3rd March 2008 at New Delhi to promote the development of a closer working relationship for the mutual benefit of their members and in the interest of the engineering and computer science profession.

Reciprocal Arrangements

- Attendance of the members at the technical events organized by the other organization will be on the same conditions as applicable to the members of the host organization.
- Publications to the members of the other organization shall be available at the same rates as applicable to the host Institution members.
- IEI and CEAI will jointly develop a programme leading to the facilitation of individual members wishing to acquire the membership of the other organization.
- IEI and CEAI will exchange all publications on complimentary basis. Both the
 organizations agree to prominently display publications of the other
 organization in their respective libraries for review by members.

Joint Activities

 Joint sponsoring of seminars, conferences and meetings of mutual interest will be encouraged. Details shall be finalized for each joint activity on case to case basis.

 IEI and CEAI will develop a Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP) relating to technical education and certification of competence of engineers of relevant discipline.

Review, Amendment and Termination

- 7. This Agreement shall continue for three years. Thereafter, it will be renewed automatically for a further three years if not terminated by either organization. Amendments to the Agreement may be proposed at any time but will be valid only on the approval of the Councils of both organizations. The Agreement may be terminated by either organization on giving others six months notice in writing.
- The infrastructure facilities of each organization will be made available to the other organization on a preferential basis at mutually accepted terms.

Ratification

The Agreement shall not be binding until it has been formally approved by the Councils of both the IEI and the CEAI.
